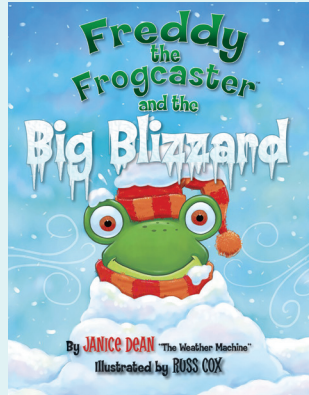


# Make Your Own Snow Gauge with **Freddy the Frogcaster**



## Hi Friends,

If you love winter weather like I do, you know it's all about the snow. When it snows, the first thing curious kidcasters want to know is this—how much did we get? To find out, follow these simple instructions to make your very own, super simple snow gauge.

### **First, rinse and soak the label off an empty**

2-liter plastic soda bottle OR milk container

### **Ask an adult to help you**

Carefully cut off the top of the bottle or container so that it is even all the way around

### **Use a permanent marker and a ruler**



To put marks on the bottle or container to show inches or centimeters. Or you can use water-proof tape to place a plastic ruler, unsharpened pencil, or drinking straw into the container or bottle.

### **Before the snow starts falling**

Place your snow catcher outside on a flat surface away from trees or buildings.

### **After the snow stops falling**

Bundle up and go outside to see how much snow is inside your snow gauge.
